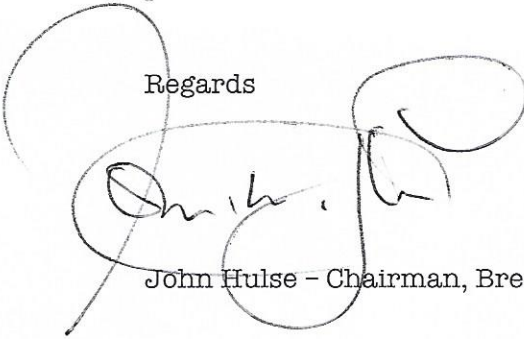
Speed Limit Outside Bredenbury School

You will be aware that we have been campaigning for a speed restriction outside the entrance of Bredenbury School for nearly 3 years. Despite several delays, we have been informed finally that our request has now been given priority which I hope you will agree is great news. Bredenbury School is one of only two schools in Herefordshire with a 60mph speed limit outside the school gates so I hope you agree that this proposal is long overdue. Many of you have already signalled your support for this initiative as part of our Neighbourhood Plan consultation but the authorities are obliged to carry out a consultation exercise for all residents who would be affected by the speed restriction to gauge their support. They will also conduct a traffic speed survey as part of this exercise.

The proposal is to impose the 30mph zone from the junction of Harp Lane with the A44 and to extend along Harp Lane beyond all of the houses on this end of Harp lane and St Andrews Close. In addition, the zone would include the entire length of Valley View. The attached map shows the proposed speed restriction zone marked in pink. We have also requested that consideration be given for additional restrictions including a 20mph speed limit during the periods at the start and finish of the school day.

We hope that you support this initiative and will reply accordingly when you receive the consultation documentation. However, if you would like to discuss or comment further please do not hesitate to contact us via the details provided below.
